- ❖ Open to 7th, 8th, & 9th grade students.
- ❖ Assist with **school activities** such as Fall Festival, Goblin Chase, and Teacher Appreciation Week.
- ❖ Participate in **Team Building Activities.**
- ❖ Learn **Leadership Skills.**
- ❖ Plan and participate in 2 **service activities** outside of school.
- ❖ Help **promote inclusivity** in the school.
- ❖ Great place to make new friendships.

What is Time Commitment to be a PTSA Ambassador?

- ❖ Attend bi-monthly meetings (**2nd & 4th Tues of Month from 3-3:45**).
Must attend 75% of time to remain active. (Musical or other activities, let advisors know)

- ❖ You will be **notified that you are selected** as a PTSA Ambassador by **receiving a certificate** from our Advisors (**Ms. Rider & Mrs. Dayton**) by **Sept 6 (Fri).**
- ❖ **Grades must remain in good standing,** no D's or F's. Citizenship grades no N or U's.
Participation in PTSA Ambassadors may be put on probation due to grade or citizenship issues.
- ❖ In the event there are more applicants than our capacity, the **applications will be reviewed in date order they were turned in.**
