Our 2023-24 TSSA plan was so helpful for our school. We have strong instructional coaches (two part-time coaches) who were able to spend many hours with most of our teachers this year, helping them with classroom management, content delivery, and planning. Most of our teachers also enjoyed paid professional development opportunities to help them enhance their pedagogy. An essential part of our TSSA plan was to pay to replace old student Chromebooks, as well as to improve teacher technology and renew software licenses. Finally, we will be using some of the funds to support our growing need to help students develop a sense of belonging by paying a stipend to club advisors and for any club needs. We have expanded our clubs from just two last year to over 15 clubs this year to create opportunities for students to find others who share similar interests and feel more belonging here at school. We have already seen an improvement in Panorama in this area and we give credit to a variety of things, but especially to the development of our clubs. Next year's plan should be fairly similar due to our needs and the fact that we are observing better teaching practices (higher JPAS scores), fewer failed classes, better technology, and a more positive sense of belonging at Elk Ridge.
